WALKING DIRECTIONS: from the Convention Center or Hyatt, walk east to 16th street and board a mall shuttle running north (away from the Capitol) and ride it to Larimer Street. Cross back over 16th, following Larimer, walking toward the mountains. Cross 15th, 14th, and Speer. You will see the Tivoli, a brick building with a vaguely Bavarian style ahead. Continue down Larimer along the soccer field. Enter the Tivoli at the base of its tower (look for a sign that says "Hop Storage"). Just inside the door on your left you'll find a stairway and an elevator. Take either of these to the 4th floor. Emerging from elevator or stairs, bear to your right and enter the Adirondacks Room (440).

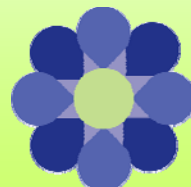
